Students who are not enrolled for consecutive semesters (break in enrollment) will be allowed to complete degree requirements under the curriculum they start under provided that their break in enrollment at Cheyney University is no longer than four regular semesters (two years) not counting summer sessions. Any breaks longer than four regular semesters will require a student to be re-admitted under the current curriculum in place at the time of their return.
